

Indian Olympic Association (IOA) ⇒ Indian Olympic Association

was established in 1972. Sir Dorabji Tata and Dr. Noehren became the founder president and Secretary General respectively of Indian Olympic Association. It is affiliated to International Olympic Committee. ~~It~~ Sir Dorabji Jamshedji Tata was also elected the first IOC member in India. The election of the office bearers of the Indian Olympic Association is held after every four years. The council consists of various members like president, nine vice-president, six joint secretaries, one secretary general, one honorary treasurer, seven representatives of the state Olympic association and twelve representatives of national sports federations or associations.

Functions and Objectives of Indian Olympic Association

1. Development and promotion of the Olympic movement
2. Enforcement of all rules and regulations of the IOC and IOA
3. To be the official organisation in complete form and whole charge of all the matters related to Olympic event.
4. Promotion and encouragement of the physical, moral and cultural education of the young people of the nation.

YMCA College of Physical Education (Chennai) ⇒

YMCA College of Physical Education (Chennai) was founded by Mr. Harry Crowe Buck in 1920. In the beginning, it was the YMCA Training School of Physical Education but in 1932 it was expanded in the form of a college in 65 acre campus.

Objectives of the College =>

1. To prepare teaching personnel who can serve the community in the areas of health, physical education and sports.
2. To provide training in the area of sports and physical education with the ~~and~~ a strong scientific base.
3. To conduct programme of extension service to the community.
4. To provide social and ethical dimensions of personal development.

Lucknow Christian College of Physical Education (LCCPE)

In 1862, a tiny school in the Husainabad area of the old city of Lucknow was started. It was established by Rev. J.H. Moesmore a pioneer educationalist missionary in Lucknow. In 1882, this institution was raised to the level of high school. In 1888, it was established as Reid Christian Intermediate College. After that in 1889, the Degree College. After that keeping in view the need of professional courses a Teacher's Training College was established in 1932. During the same year under the leadership of Mr. E.W. Ted Munby, a pioneer of physical education in Northern India, the college of Physical Education was established. The motto of this college is - OMNIA AD DEI GLORIAM taken from Latin which mean - All to the Glory of God. In 1996, the college of physical education was upgraded to ~~and up to the~~ post graduate level by sterling Master's Degree of physical education (M.P.Ed).

Luxmibai National University of Physical Education (LNUPE)

Luxmibai National University of Physical Education, popularly known as LNUPE was established by Ministry of Education & Culture, Govt. of India as Luxmibai College of Physical Education on August 17, 1957. This college was named after Rani Luxmibai of Jhansi, a brave of the Indian war of Independence, as a tribute to her role in the glorious freedom struggle in 1857. She laid her life in Gwalior, the historic city of India. This college started as an affiliated college of the Vikram University, Ujjain. In 1964 it was affiliated to Jiwaji University, Gwalior. It became very famous institution of Physical Education, hence, it was renamed as Luxmibai National College of Physical Education which was popularly known as LNCPE. For its unique status and further development, it was given the status of 'Autonomous College' in 1982. Owing to its unique educational services rendered by this college in the field of Physical Education, Sports and Research the Govt. of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development conferred the status of 'Deemed to be university' in Sept. 1995. It was again renamed as LNIPE. On Jan. 14, 2009, the institute was renamed as Luxmibai National University of Physical Education.

The main aim of establishing this university was to upgrade the status of physical education in India by producing best quality teachers and leaders through graduate and post graduate courses. Three years Bachelor of Physical Education (BPE) was started in 1957 and two years Master of Physical Education M.P.E. in 1963. After that, Master of Philosophy in Physical Education M. Phil.-one year was started. Doctor of Philosophy in Physical Education (Ph.D.) on regular as well as part time basis was also commenced. Various certificate, diploma and PG diploma courses were also started in different disciplines of physical education and sports afterwards. The duration of B.P.E. was enhanced to 4 years instead of 3 years and the name of the course was renamed as B.P.Ed. an integrated course.
