5. How does Caliban respond to Trinculo?
6. What are Stephano's plans for the island and for Caliban and Trinculo?
7. What is Caliban's attitude towards Stephano and why do you think this is?
8. Collect THREE examples of insults used by either Trinculo or Caliban.
9. Collect THREE examples of commanding language used by Stephano.
10. How does Caliban portray Prospero in this scene?
11. Explain how Ariel causes arguments between Trinculo, Stephano and Caliban.
12. What does Caliban want Stephano to do to Prospero and why?
13. According to Caliban, why should they destroy Prospero's books?
14. What does Ariel do to draw the three drunken characters further into Prospero's scheme?
15. According to Caliban, what can often be heard on the island?
